



## SGU CHALLENGE

### WIN A ROUND WITH RYDER CUP STAR DAVID HOWELL

#### CONDITIONS

##### GENERAL RULES

The Cleveland Golf / Srixon Challenge is open to all members of SGU affiliated clubs.

Each member of an SGU affiliated Club is invited to enter by submitting the official entry form detailing the nett score and CSS from a Club Qualifying Competition during the period Friday 10 July to Friday 7 August (inclusive).

Members of SGU affiliated clubs may enter individually or Golf Club Administrators may enter on behalf of their members. However entrants must be available to play at the Torrance Course, Fairmont, St Andrews on Monday 17 August (see prizes below for further details) and the entry form must be certified by both the entrant and entrant's Club Administrator.

All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and must be received at SGU Head Office (address details below) no later than Tuesday 11 August.

Each Entry Form must be accompanied with a photocopy of the scorecard that the entry relates too. The copy of the scorecard is required to calculate stableford points in the event of a tie.

Stroke Play events only may be used as qualification for the Cleveland Golf / Srixon Challenge (Stableford, Bogey or Par events may not).

Scores returned in abandoned competitions are not eligible.

The nett scores from all entry forms received will be recorded in three categories and entered into a national ranking table relative to each respective CSS and posted on the Scottish Golf Union website [www.scottishgolf.org](http://www.scottishgolf.org). The three categories will be as follows:

Category 1: Plus to 9

Category 2: H'cap 10 to 15

Category 3: H'cap 16 to 28

There is no limit to how many times an individual enters however each score recorded must be submitted on a separate entry form.

The handicap detailed on each entry form submitted will determine which handicap category a player is allocated to on the national ranking table.

All disputes will be decided by the SGU whose decision will be final.

Cleveland Golf / Srixon or the SGU will not be held responsible for entry forms which are lost, damaged in the post or for forms which arrive after the closing date.

## QUALIFICATION

To be eligible to enter, a player must:

- a) be male at birth and of Amateur Status as defined by R&A Rules Limited,
- b) be 16 years or over on the first day of the qualifying period i.e. Friday 10 July,
- c) be a member of a Scottish Golf Union affiliated club,
- d) be in possession of an official CONGU Handicap as allocated by the player's home club,
- e) only represent one Golf Club in the event.

## PRIZES

The winner in each handicap category will qualify to play with 2-time Ryder Cup star David Howell at the Torrance Course, Fairmont, St Andrews on Monday 17 August ahead of the Cleveland / Srixon Scottish Seniors Open Championship. All entrants to the challenge must be able to play on Monday 17 August. Complimentary tea/coffee, bacon rolls and lunch will be provided. All other expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the individuals.

Cleveland Golf Equipment and Srixon Golf Balls will be awarded to runners-up in each handicap category and every golfer who enters will receive a complimentary pair of season tickets to the Cleveland / Srixon Scottish Seniors Open Championship.

In the event of a tie for the main prize winners in each handicap category stableford points will be calculated for the score returned, with the highest total being the winner. In the event of a tie the following countback procedure will be applied:

*The best stableford score on holes 10-18 and if still a tie*

*The best stableford score on holes 13-18 and if still a tie*

*The best stableford score on holes 16-18 and if still a tie*

*Match play on the best stableford score on the card, hole by hole from the 1<sup>st</sup> hole.*

An entrant who has recorded more than one entry within the same handicap category may only win one prize. In this eventuality the entrants higher placing will be used to determine the prize awarded.

An entrant who is recorded in more than one handicap category may only win one prize. In this eventuality the entrants results will be accessed and prize awarded to the higher placing.
